To Whom it May Concern:

Due to the historically low snowpack conditions for the Sun River Watershed and the projected summer weather patterns for our area, the GID Board of Commissioners has reduced this year's irrigation allotment to 1.0 acre-foot per acre. This is half of the normal allotment of two acre-feet per acre. The irrigation season will start approximately the middle to late May, and it will extend until our usable water storage in Gibson and Pishkun Reservoirs has been exhausted. Hopefully moisture conditions improve throughout the summer.
